- 1. The Chairman highlighted the following main points discussed at the last Executive Committee meeting held on 3 April 2009:

Annual Report 2008/09 by Chairman

- 3. Members accepted the Chairman's Annual Report for 2008/09 which covered the following main points:
 - a) Financial sponsorship provided by OBA to support the development of CHECSS students –A student won championship in a Speech open competition and the results of CHECSS in various sports competitions were encouraging.
 - b) A Chinese translation of the School Song prepared by some OBA members aimed at helping students understand the CHECSS spirit better (The school might consider to organize a translation competition for students).
 - c) The OBA website –due to lacking of technical support, the task for enhancing its features are to be accomplished by assigning it to a special force in the coming year.
 - d) Fund raising campaign the target of \$100,000 set in 2006 was achieved and a new target for 2009/10 would be set (an appeal made by the Chairman for members' support)
 - e) The 3rd Issue of "The Way We Were" to be published by the School OBA would continue to help provide contacts of outstanding alumni.

- 6. Principal Li briefed members on the following points of common interest:
 - a) Possible sites of relocation of CHECSS reference made to his progress report in the October 2009 issue of CHECSS PTA Newsletter.
 - b) Report on School Value Added Information CHECSS had amicable Value-added results, being top 25% in the Wong Tai Sin district. In the 2009 HKCEE, both the grades of 86% of all subjects and the number of Grade C or above achieved were higher than the territory- wide average. With the good promotion efforts made by teachers, the School had not encountered any problem in student recruitment.
 - c) Notable achievements in sports Tsui Chi Ho (CHECSS graduate) is a member of the HKSAR delegation to join the Athletics (100m) event of the 11th National Games of PRC (中 國全國運動會) 2009. The School also maintained highly satisfactory results in various local Interschool Athletics competitions.
